WORLD KINDNESS DAY NOVEMBER 13TH



As we enter the time of year where diaries fill up and life gets even busier...it is so important to take some time out and to be kind to yourself.

Self-kindness, or self-compassion, is the practice of treating yourself with understanding and care, especially when you're experiencing pain or failure.

It can help you:

Feel connected to others
Recognize that your experiences are part of the human experience, and that
you're not alone in your suffering

Be mindful
Hold your thoughts and feelings in balanced awareness, without overidentifying with them

Be tolerant of your shortcomings
Treat your worth as unconditional, even when you fall short of your own
expectations

Cope with stress
Self-compassion can help you identify ways to alleviate stress

Here are some ways to practice self-kindness:

Compliment yourself

Practice gratitude

Speak to yourself with kindness

Prioritise self-care

Set realistic goals

Forgive yourself

Take a break to acknowledge your stress

Ask yourself what you would say to a friend in the same situation

Notice when you are being critical of yourself.
