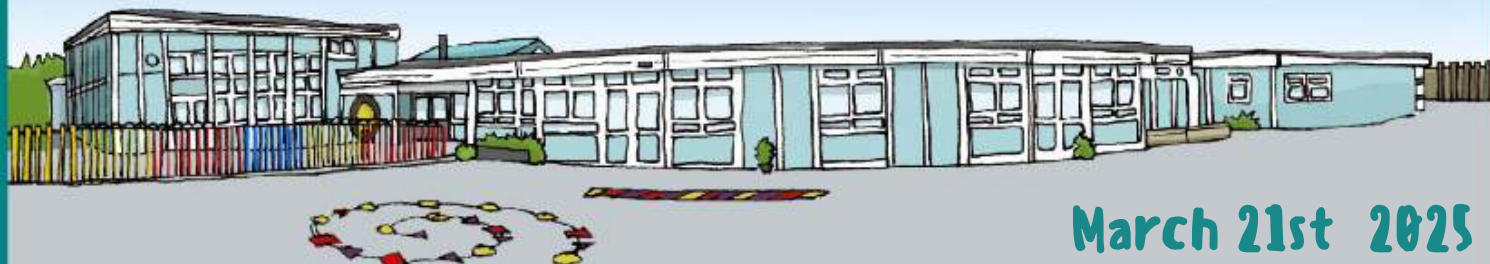

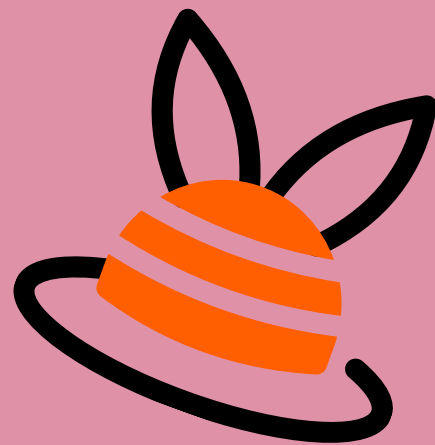
## Guided Self-Help

An initial assessment will help identify the issues that are having a negative impact on your mental health. This may take place over 6-8 weeks.

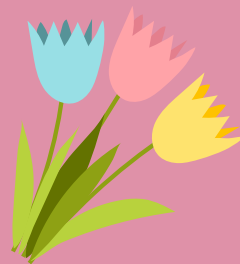
Using materials from The Centre of Clinical Interventions, based on the principles of CBT these sessions cover a variety of areas:

Self Compassion | Procrastination  
Assertiveness | Generalised Anxiety  
Worry | Panic | Loss and Grief

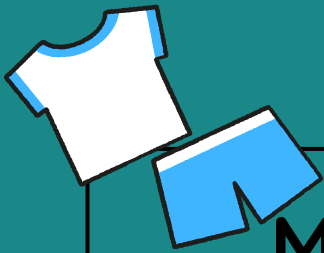
