





An inital assessment will help identify the issues that are having a negative impact on your mental health. This may take place over 6-8 weeks.

Using materials from The Centre of Clinical Interventions, based on the principles of CBT these sessions cover a variety of areas:

Depression | Social Anxiety | Distress
Intolerance | Self Esteem | Perfectionism
Self Compassion | Procrastination
Assertiveness | Generalised Anxiety
Worry | Panic | Loss and Grief
