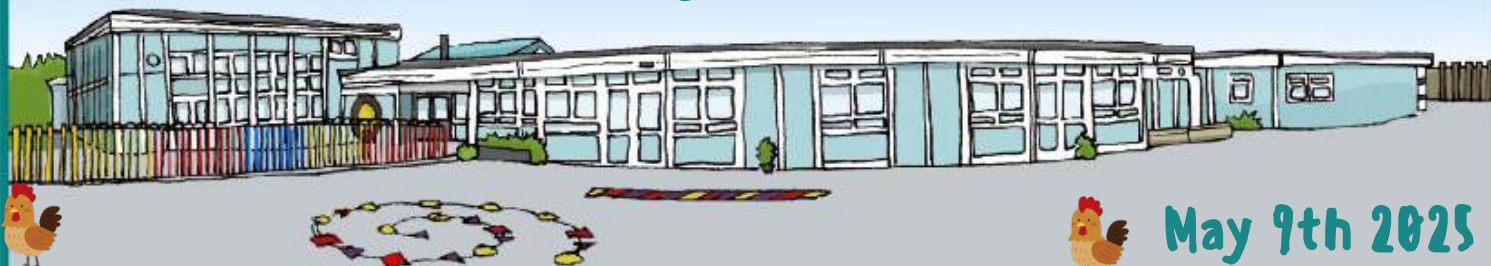

Yesterday Gwenfo played against Llandaff City Church in Wales primary School.

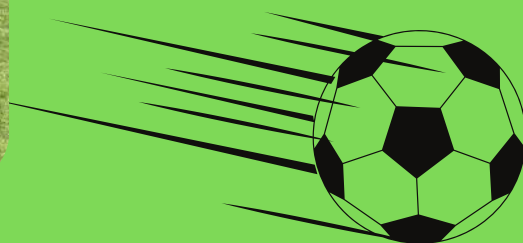
The whole team played exceptionally well. At halftime the match was evenly poised at 1-1 after a well taken goal by Theo.

Plant Sale

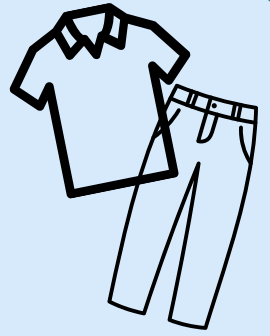


Apologies for no sale last week - will be holding a plant sale on Tuesday 13th May after school.

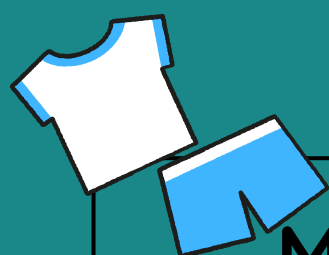

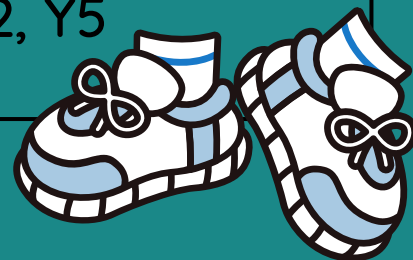
Games and PE days
