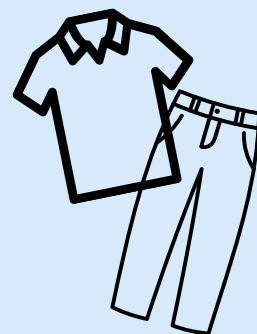


Service Families

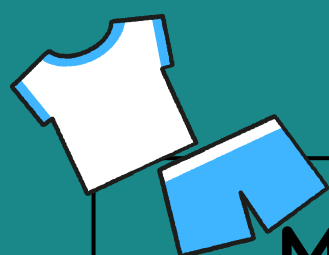

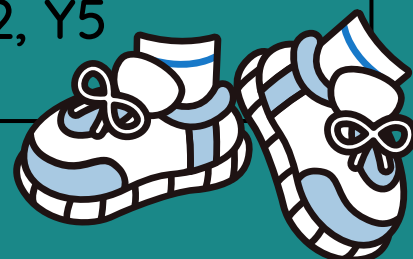
Games and PE days
