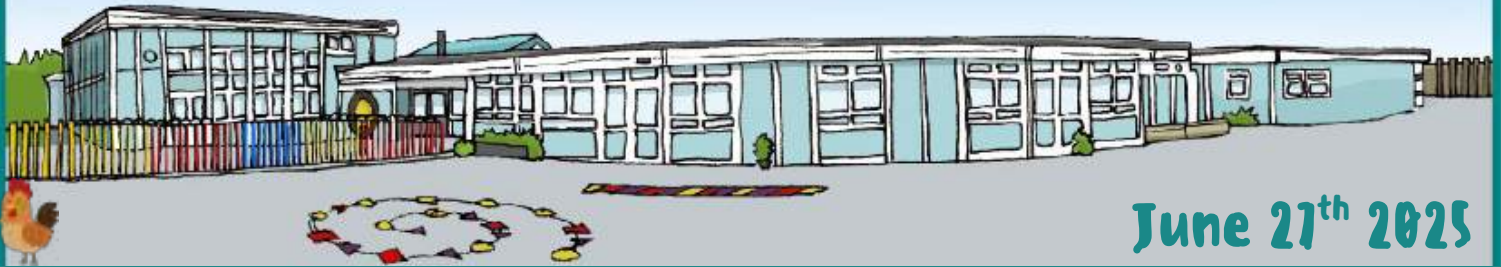

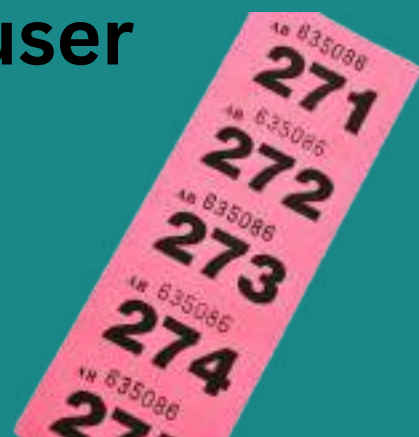

We recommend you use your eggs within 28 days of laying.



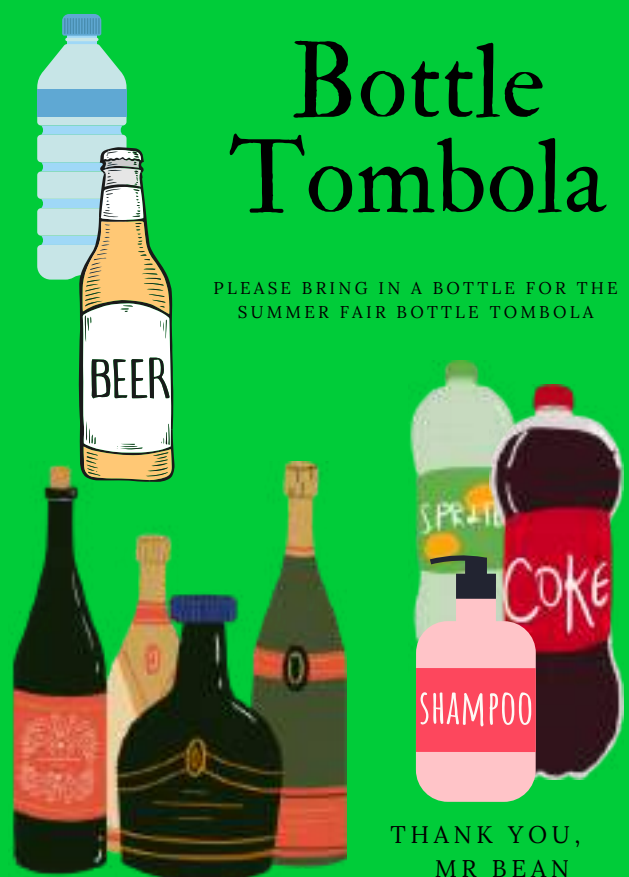
Service Families
